

RALPH STANLEY — was born February 25, 1927, in Dickenson County, Virginia. He graduated from Ervinton High School at Nora, Virginia in 1945. Fourteen days later, at age of 18 years, he entered the U. S. Army, serving one year in General Patton's Third Army in Germany (World War II.) After his discharge in October, 1946, he, with his brother, Carter, organized what was known as "The Stanley Brothers and Clinch Mountain Boys." This band was very active until Carter's death in December, 1966.

During their 20 years together they recorded over 500 songs and instrumentals. They toured in 42 states and seven foreign countries. Since Carter's passing on December 1, 1966, Ralph has carried on with the show and has recorded three long-play albums, two of which have been released. Ralph says he misses Carter very much but has no intention of quiting as long as you people support him as you have in the last year and a half. Ralph wants to take this opportunity to thank each and everyone for the wonderful way you (his fans) have received him and his "Clinch Mountain Boys."

CURLY RAY CLINE — was born near Gilbert, W. Va., and started playing the fiddle when very young. He was one of the original "Lonesome Pine Fiddlers" until two years ago when he began playing the fiddle with "The Stanley Brothers" and now Ralph Stanley.

MELVIN GOINS — was born in the state of West Virginia. His first professional work was with the "Lonesome Pine Fiddlers." He has been with this show for nearly three years. He plays rhythm guitar and doubles on comedy as "Big Wilbur."

LARRY SPARKS — joined Ralph Stanley immediately after Carter passed away and has been with the show since that time. He sings lead and plays lead as well as rhythm guitar. Larry was born in Lebanon, Ohio, and began playing "Stanley Brothers" songs at a very young age. He is the youngest member of the show and this was his first professional job in show business.
